Awareness of persons, places, buildings, materials.

PART II

Three dimensional- perception: Understanding and appreciation of scale and proportion of objects, buildings forms and elements, colour texture, harmony and contrast.

Design and drawing of geometrical or abstract shapes and patterns in pencil.

Transformation of forms both 2D to 3D union, subtraction, rotation, development of surfaces and volumes, Generation of Plan, elevations and three dimensional compositions using given shapes and forms.

Sketching of scenes and activities from memory of urbanscape (public space, market, festival, street scenes, monuments, recreational spaces etc.), landscape (river fronts, jungles, gardens, trees, plants etc.) and rural life.
