### **What is the use of Previous Papers**

Previous papers from pas years can be more valuable resource when revising. There are many ways in which previous exam papers can benefit your revision and help prepare you for the real exam.

Many competitive previous exam papers are now available online and you can download them from the link from [www.recruitmenttopper.com](http://www.recruitmenttopper.com) for revision. Remember that previous exam papers will help you to predict which questions or topics are most likely to come up in the exam.

But trying to identify trends in previous years exam papers is not a productive way to learn your subject or focus your revision and is a risky strategy. However, you might find it valuable to use previous papers in the following ways:

### **For practice and Revision**

The main common benefit of previous papers is simply to practice answering the questions, especially near the time of the exam itself. This can help you:

- to assess ability how you go through exam or to determine the gaps in your knowledge;
- to familiarise yourself with the format of the exam, the type of questions and the style in which they are phrased.

For competitive exams format of the exam may change from year to year you should read the instructions when you attend the real exam. Do not think that they are the same as previous papers.

### **Better to practice previous papers under 'exam conditions', and this can be helpful**

- to estimate if you have a ability to apply in the examination what you have learned under pressure.
- to get used to the time constraint, to see how much you can write in the time
- By comparing questions with lecture notes to get an idea of the full range of topics which may come up in the exam;
- List of topics that are coming in the examination need revised with out revising all topics.
- You avoid revising in unnecessary depth in the Subject
- Analyse them to find out not just what topics might come up, but the sort of questions that are asked, and how they phrase them.
- When you are revising, ask yourself what kinds of questions might be asked about the material you are learning, using past papers on similar topics as a guide.
